Fine Arts (1 Credit)	<i>Credits are calculated based on a combination of Music, Art, and Drama related courses.</i> 1 day a week courses of individual or combined courses (.25 each) 2 or 3 days a week courses (.5 each) <sup>4</sup>
Physical Training/Athletics (1 Credit)	<i>Credits are calculated based on a combination of courses and participation in school athletics or an approved outside sport with documentation for minimum equivalent hours met.</i> Fr/Soph 2 day a week (.5 each) Jr/Sr Athletic participation (.25 per sport)
Elective (1 Credit)	<i>Credits are calculated based on a combination of electives offered.</i> 1 day a week courses (.25 each) 2 or 3 days a week courses (.5 each) <sup>5</sup>
